Containing one hundred & sixty acres & two hundredths of an acre

of the Lands directed to be sold at *Huntsville* in pursuance of the Laws providing for the sale of the Lands of the **UNITED STATES** in **MISSISSIPPI AND ALABAMA**, There is Granted, by the United States, unto the said *Golden Fields & to his heirs* the *quarter* lot or section of Land above described:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said *quarter* lot or section of Land, with the Appurtenances, unto the said *Golden Fields & to his* heirs and assigns forever.
